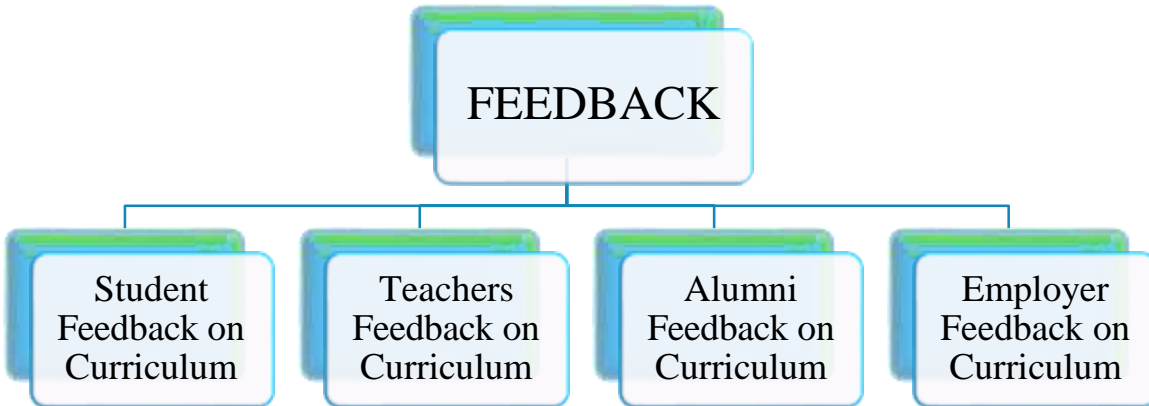
**ACADEMIC YEAR: 2018-19**

The newly introduced system of manual feedback has proved to be an effective tool for continuous improvement in the teaching and learning process and developed a sense of confidence amongst all the stakeholders. The students and alumni were happy to record their feedback with the feeling that they have a little say in the system and their feedback is taken up at various levels for corrections for overall improvement in the college education.

The overall analysis of the Feedback forms collected as analyzed by the Feedback committee after careful scrutiny of all the forms is summarized as follows:

## **FINDINGS & SUGGESTIONS**

### **FINDINGS:**

After a careful collection and analysis of the feedbacks on the Curriculum the committee offered its opinion as follows:-

#### **Students**

Almost all the students have given positive feedback on the curriculum of all the courses framed by the BOS University of Mumbai. And we observe that some of the students want the balance between theoretical as well as practical learning. Very few students have opined that the percentage of practical and experiential learning shall be more than the theory.

#### **Teachers**

It is observed that most of the teachers have given a positive feedback on the syllabus of all the courses barring some subjects like Indirect Tax where in more practical aspects needs to be implemented.

#### **Alumni**

The alumni members mostly are satisfied with the curriculum and some of the alumni expressed their feedback that the applicability of the bookish knowledge at the work place is very less. The curriculum thus is acceptable with very less degree of dissatisfaction.

## SUGGESTIONS

**The meetings of the HOD's or Senior Teachers in the departments were conducted with IQAC and Principal** to discuss the Student's feedback report on curriculum. The feedback monitoring system helped the subject teachers to identify the strengths and weaknesses of present curriculum. In view of improvement in the process, the following suggestions were offered:

- The subject teachers shall attend the workshops organized by BOS in respective subjects and get acquainted with the course delivery system.
- The syllabus revision workshops shall be attended by all the teachers and respective course heads
- The college shall discuss academic indicators in the yearly Staff Induction Program.
- The College shall organize National/International Seminar/Conference or Workshops on Syllabus oriented topics and encourage students to participate.
- The subject teacher should offer guidance regarding curriculum as well as career oriented counselling shall be offered.
- The department should organize Co-Curricular Activities for better understanding of curriculum.
- The subject teacher should make use of ICT in teaching learning process to make it more effective.

## ACTION TAKEN REPORT

After careful analysis and perusal of the feedback forms and its GRADES, the Feedback committee in association with the IQAC of the College has recorded the Action Taken report in this regard for the overall improvement in the curriculum delivery system. The brief report of ATR is as follows:

7	Students were sent for the <b>internship</b> to gain the practical knowledge of the subject and develop <b>employability skills</b> .

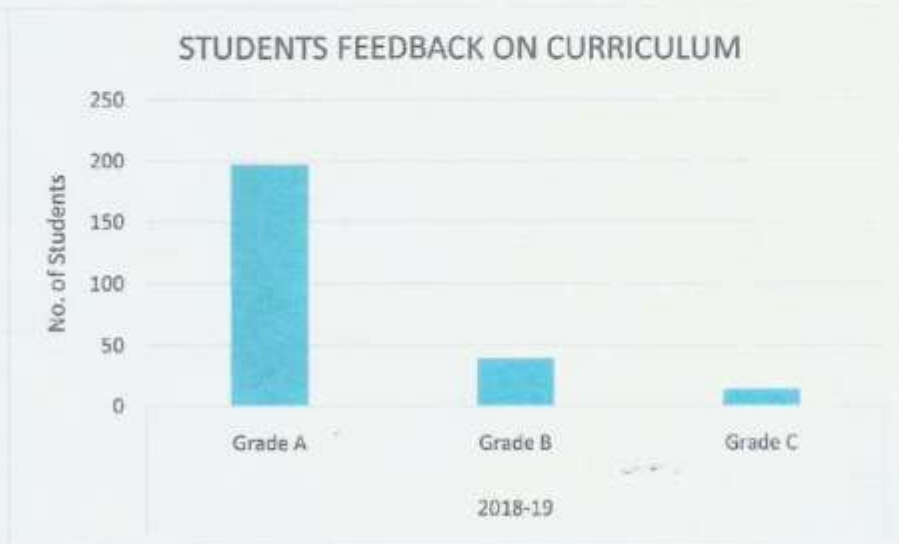

We have 250 feedback form of students on curriculum out of which 197 students are satisfied with the current curriculum, 39 students agree that the syllabus needs some improvements in some aspects, 14 students are very less satisfied as we can see the analysis in the below diagram:

In above diagram, 79% of student's is satisfied with current curriculum 16% is agreed and 6% students is less satisfied.

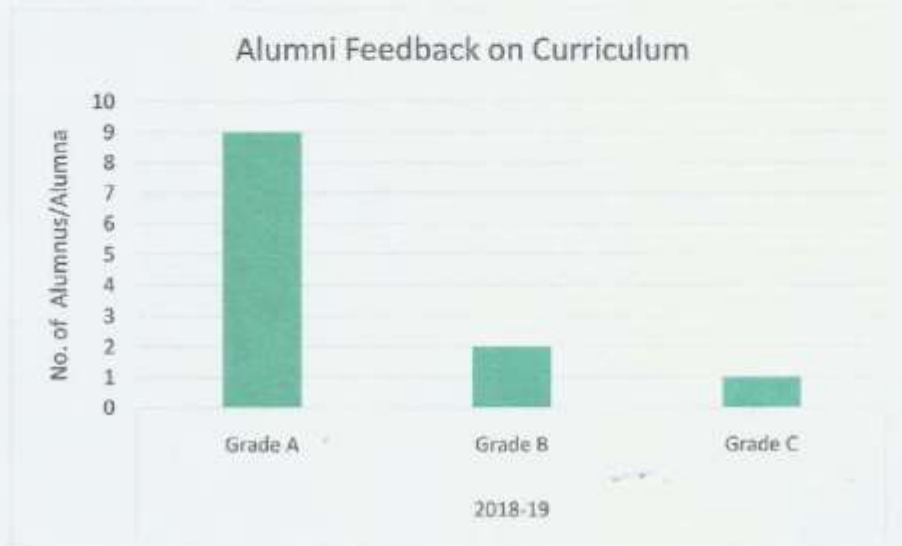
