#### PART-I INTRODUCTION

Achievers College of Commerce and Management (Night College), Kalyan, is affiliated to University of Mumbai since the year 2013 and is a self-financing Institution. It was founded by Shree Dnyanraj Mauli Shikshan Seva Mandal, Kalyan, by a visionary educationist Dr. (CA) Mahesh Bhiwandikar Since the inception the College was being housed and managed in a small building located at Jai bhagwan Tower Murlidhar Aali, Par Naka, Tilak Chowk Kalyan and later from 12th June, 2018 it was shifted to its present location at Joshi Baug, Malhar Nagar, Kalyan. The College has five UG and One PG Program. College has framed its own vision, mission, Core Values & objectives, according to the national policy which involves quality promotion and its sustenance.

The College is the only Night College in the city of Kalyan and surrounding region. College is ISO-2009:2015 certified institution and also is recognized under section 2 (f) of University Grants Commission.

Being a night college, it caters to the needs of working class of the students and also offers internship and job placements to needy students. The greed to learn and gain work experience are aligned by the College Mantra "Earn While You Learn". It has a unique feature of catering to the needs of working class of girls, who strive hard to maintain the balance between family and their career. The College also offers internships and placements to the needy girl students.

College is both Staff and Student friendly. Majority of the staff are women. The infrastructure is designed in the interest of both the staff and students. Spacious classrooms, good ventilation, white boards, blackboards, overhead projectors and comfortable seating system with Stair case on both the sides of the floor makes it convenient for every stakeholder. Each floor is facilitated with staff room, washrooms, notice boards in such a way to have easy access to the students and the staff.

College offers various UG, PG, skilled based, Government approved computer courses and Add-on Certificate courses. College also has NSS Unit, Career Counseling Cell, Business Incubator, Campus to Corporate Placement Cell, Women Development Cell and a Help Desk to counsel, groom and motivate students.

A special help line 'Jatayu' is available for girl students 24 x 7 x 365.

The College has young and enthusiastic team of Teaching and Support staff headed by the dynamic Principal who dedicatedly work under the able guidance of the Chairman.

#### GENDER SENSITIZATION ACTION PLAN

- The Principal of the College under the able guidance from College Development Committee are responsible for overall admissions and safety of girls in the Campus.
- 2. The admission to the girls to the College shall be granted on priority basis.
- The College shall have CCTV surveillance throughout the campus for the overall safety and security of the Girls on the campus.
- 4. The Women Development Cell shall be formed as follows:

  - b. A Female faculty as Convener
  - e. One Lady Teaching Staff
  - d. One Lady Non-Teaching Staff
  - e. Female Representative of Students Council.
- The Women Development Cell shall work as per the guidelines framed by the University and UGC.
- WDC shall organize programs on the following topics:
  - a. Orientation program in the beginning of the year
  - b. Gender Sensitization
  - c. Blind Faith and drugs addiction
  - d. Pre-marriage Counseling
  - e. Health and Hygiene
  - f. Legal rights of women
  - g. Sensitization workshops on Laws and rules to safeguard Girls
- The dignity of women shall be maintained on the campus and the complaints in the regard shall be dealt with severely.

- A special help line number shall be made available with WDC under the title
  "JATAYU" which shall render the immediate help to the girls facing any
  unprecedented events. The helpline shall be made available 24x7x365.
- The Prevention of sexual harassment Cell shall seriously deal with the cases of Sexual harassment on the campus as per the rules and regulations led by University.
- 10. The class teacher shall act as a personal mentor for the girls and shall carefully look after the mental health of the students. Every minute deviation shall be seriously dealt with.
- Self- defense workshop shall be conducted twice a year.







### PART-IV



 V CARE: - The College has a facility of "V Care" where in babysitting facility is provided for the kids of students and teachers while they are engaged in lectures on the Campus.





















